

White Label

If you choose to label the products yourself, you must, by law, include the following information on your label –

- The product name – the name that appears on the cosmetic product notification portal.
- Directions of use (if not obvious from the product name)
- Full ingredients list (including allergens)
- Safety warnings – as determined by the assessing chemist.
- The product weight (if not single use)
- The product use by or best before date (POA)
- The product use by date, normally a symbol denoting months after first use
- The batch number (issued by Taylor's Savonnerie and may change with each batch you order which you will need to update on your label)
- Manufacturers/Responsible Person name and contact details (Claire-Louise Taylor)

For example: Handmade in France for *your business name* by Claire-Louise Taylor, 17240 Champagnolles, France.

Apart from the batch number the rest of the information can be copied and pasted each time for that product label.

You are then required to send us a picture of your label for it to be uploaded to the current listing on the Cosmetic Product Notification Portal – this needs to be added to show the different label design for traceability.
